**Clinical Duties of Fellow:** National Spine Fellowship - Integrated orthopaedic and neurosurgical fellowship in complex spine surgery. Full time clinical post with a busy timetable including taking part in the Spinal Fellow rota with second on-call responsibilities for spinal surgery one day a week (8am until 8pm). On average three lists each week (three session days), one day of acute work and one day of clinic. Ward responsibilities overseeing junior medical staff alongside a daily Consultant delivered ward round.

**Research Duties of Fellow:** Opportunity to take a three months post looking into a research question of your choice. Close links with the University of Leeds including a world renowned biomedical research facility and a leading clinical trials research unit. Active clinical research unit (Leeds Spine Research Group) that meets every month.

**Other details for Fellowship/Clinical Visit:** Leeds Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust is one of the largest teaching hospitals in Europe with an annual budget of over £1 billion and more than 2000 inpatient beds across seven sites. Working alongside the University of Leeds, it includes a world renowned biomedical research facility and a leading clinical trials research unit.
