Clinical Duties of Fellow: Interface Fellowship in Spine Surgery - Integrated orthopaedic and neurosurgical fellowship in complex spine surgery. Full time clinical post with a busy timetable including taking part in the Spinal Fellow rota with second on-call responsibilities for spinal surgery one day a week (8am until 8pm). On average three lists each week (three session days), one day of acute work and one day of clinic. Ward responsibilities overseeing junior medical staff alongside a daily Consultant delivered ward round.

Research Duties of Fellow: Opportunity to take part in research projects. Strong links with the University of Leeds including a world renowned biomedical research facility and a leading clinical trials research unit. Active clinical research group (Leeds Spine Research Group) with meetings every month.

Other details for Fellowship/Clinical Visit: Leeds Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust is one of the largest
